Sealed proposals for Comingled Recycling Line Renovations, will be received by the Carroll County Solid Waste Management Commission at the Recycling Center, 19111 Kittyhawk Avenue, Carroll, Iowa 51401 (mailing address 19111 Kittyhawk Avenue, Box 17, Carroll, Iowa 51401), until February 7, 2019 at 10:00 a.m., local time, for the following::

*Design, build, install, and start-up recycling process equipment as described in the Request for Proposal. Project includes removal of the existing comingled recycling processing equipment, and providing and installing new comingled recycling equipment for the completion of the Comingled Recycling Line Renovations at the Carroll County Solid Waste Management Recycling Center, 19111 Kittyhawk Avenue, Carroll, Iowa.*

A recommended pre-proposal meeting will be held on January 18, 2019 at 1:00 P.M., local time, at the Recycling Center.

A hearing will be conducted on the request for proposal, form of contract and estimate of cost at a meeting of the Board to be held at a meeting of the Commission to be held at the Recycling Center, 19111 Kittyhawk Avenue, Carroll, Iowa 51401, at 8:00 am, on February 11, 2019, at which time and place any person may appear and file objections to the Request for Proposal, form of contract and estimated costs for said public improvements. Sealed proposals previously received for such project will be presented to and considered by the Board immediately after the termination of said hearing.

Proposals will be publicly opened and read at the Recycling Center immediately after the deadline for Proposals on February 7, 2019 at 10:00 am.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a Proposal Bond or certified check equivalent to **5%** of the proposers maximum proposal price, payable to the order of the Carroll County Solid Waste Management Commission, as security that the successful proposer will enter into a contract for the work proposed upon and will furnish after the award of contract a corporate surety bond, acceptable to the governing body, for the faithful performance of the contract. This sum shall be forfeited in case the proposer fails to enter into the contract within fifteen days after the contract has been awarded. No Proposer may withdraw his Proposal after the time for opening proposals has passed.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals, waive or not waive any informalities in the Proposals received and to accept any proposal which is deemed most favorable to the interests of the Owner. Proposals received after the posted time will not be opened. Some delivery services may not make the 10:00 am due time. Proposers are responsible for any delays or fault of the delivery service used.

A recommended pre-proposal conference will be held on January 18, 2019 at 1:00 P.M. local time at the Carroll County Recycling Center, 19111 Kittyhawk Avenue, Carroll, Iowa 51401. Representatives of Owner and Engineer will be present to discuss the project. Proposers are encouraged to attend and participate in the conference. Engineer will transmit to all plan holders such addenda as Engineer considers necessary in response to questions arising at the conference. Oral statements may not be relied upon and will not be binding or legally effective.
