Re: SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING MEETING

The regional recycling center in Carroll was built in 1990 and has been processing recyclables from Association members and other interested parties since that time. Minor changes have been made at the recycling center and to the recycling program throughout the years. The program is currently a two stream process with containers kept separate from the paper products and processed in two different areas.

Carroll County Solid Waste Management Commission with the assistance from Association members has hired Foth Infrastructure and Environment LLC to complete a study on the pros and cons of converting to a single stream process. Single stream recycling involves putting all recyclables materials in one cart with no sorting by the homeowners or businesses. All sorting would take place at the recycling center that would be modified to accommodate the recyclable materials mixed together.
